The Moon Side-Table is designed by Kunaal and created by Biancobianchi for VGO Associates. For this work we have chosen a common thread between the material and the story it wants to tell. In fact, the scagliola which is the Italian name for selenite, or more imaginatively called "moonstone". However, scagliola is also the art of making inlays with a special mix of colored pigments, natural glues and selenite powder. The table through its last metal reflects our image reminding us of Narciso, a young hunter who is famous for his beauty. In the myth told by Ovid, the character appears incredibly cruel, in that he disdains every person he loves. Following a divine punishment, he falls in love with his own image reflected in a body of water and dies falling into the lake where he reflected himself. But Echo and Narcissus are more than a simple mythological story of presumption, which unfortunately is what will later be defined as a syndrome also called "narcissism". Instead, the themes of history are representations of the research that humanity must undertake to find, seek and promote self-love and inner rhythm.
